Admissions Consultation – September 2027 Admissions including the Satellite Site Provision

Dear Stakeholder,

Hillview School for Girls is consulting on its Admissions Policy for September 2027. The purpose of this consultation is so that we, as a school, comply with the DfE School Admissions Code and consult with our local and wider community when there are proposed changes and/or every seven years.

The consultation has been set for a six-week period to allow the Board of Trustees to consider all comments made during the consultation window.

Period of consultation: 16th October to 1st December 2025

This consultation is being undertaken due to increasing PAN in the Hillview Sixth Form specifically at the satellite site provision. This is due to the growing popularity of the Level 1 and Level 2 offer plus on-going NEET reduction strategies for future years. This is the only adjustment to the Hillview School for Girls/Sixth Form Admissions Policy.

A copy of our proposed Admission Policy which includes our over-subscription criteria is attached to this letter.

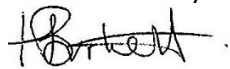
